Starry eyed

'Work with your eyes – they're your most important feature,' says face of Lancôme Werbowy. 'Enhance them all you can. I coat my bottom lashes in Lancôme Hypnôse mascara to make them look bigger. An intense blue eye is great for going out, especially if everything else on the face is kept nude.'

PARTY ON 'Almond is the most flattering eye make-up shape – extended and uplifted,' says Alex Babsky, UK make-up ambassador for Lancôme. Start by drawing along the lower lash line with Lancôme Ombre Hypnôse Mono Eye shadow in Bleu de France, £18.50, then, looking straight ahead, continue drawing outwards as far as you like. Draw the top arch to mirror the curved angle. Diffuse the edges with a fluffy brush such as Japonisque Pro Eyeshadow Fluff Brush in Medium, £14, to soften the shape. 'Colour is the statement here – it shouldn't be graphic, too,' explains Babsky. Bold colour needs a stopping point, so define eyes with Nars Night Series Eyeliner in Night Flight, £19, on your upper and lower waterlines. ▶



Sculpture class

'I love the 70s contoured look,' says Werbovy. 'I've even had tape put on my face to create perfect lines. It's about making your features work for you and knowing how to enhance your angles to make them stand out.'

PARTY ON 'Contouring is only convincing if you get the shades right' says Babsky. 'Look at the area under your chin that's always in shadow, and match the contouring shade to that colour.' Feel your cheekbones and, where they start to curve inwards, apply Tom Ford Traceless Foundation Stick, £62, in the shade best for you. Then, to emphasise where the light bounces on your cheekbones, lightly dust on Hourglass Ambient Lighting Blush Palette, £56. For a heavy-metal eye, use an angled brush to draw Max Factor Excess Shimmer Eye Shadow Pot in Crystal, £8.99, around your inner corners and apply the Onyx shade to the outer edges. Keep lips neutral with Charlotte Tilbury Matte Revolution Lipstick in Sexy Sienna, £23, and finish with Revlon Nail Enamel in Mysterious, £6.49, on your nails.

Absolutely flawless

'I fast on a water, taking just water or liquid,' says Werbovy. 'It makes my skin and eyes much brighter. Also [when you fast], a lot of emotions surface - you can see where you're at.'

PARTY ON 'For luminous skin that appears to be lit from within, apply liquid highlighter under your foundation,' says Babsky. For an ultra-polished complexion, start with BD Trade Secrets Luminance Silk Primer, £9.99, then apply Giorgio Armani Fluid Sheer in Beige, £34.50, all over your face, finishing with a sheer, liquid base such as Lancôme Teint Visionnaire Foundation, £36.50, over the top. And switch up your blusher application, too. 'Blusher on the front of the face looks pretty and outdoorsy, but moving it upwards and outwards to your temples makes it instantly more sophisticated,' explains Babsky. Lancôme Blush Subtil in 041 Figue Esplégle, £27.50, is a genius product that's the perfect tone to complement any smoky eye. ▶

Million-dollar BODY

'I love to wear sequins and sparkles, but I'm not into putting glitter on my body,' says Werbowy. 'It's more for a club or if you're going to a rave or something, with a whistle around your neck.'

PARTY ON 'To get the décolletage gleaming, treat the area to a full "facial", as you would your face,' says Sanctuary Spa skincare expert Nichola Joss. To plump out fine lines, apply Estée Lauder Revitalizing Supreme Global Anti-Aging Mask Boost, £45, down the neck and across the chest, working in circular motions, then give skin added luminosity with St Tropez Self Tanning Luxe Dry Oil, £25. ■
